Tips to Assist in Avoiding Internet Fraud:



- 1. Make certain your fire-wall/spyware software is current and up to date**
- 2. Password is protected and changed frequently**
- 3. Sign off your internet browser each time you leave internet banking**
- 4. Don't open emails from unknown senders**
- 5. Never leave your computer unattended while using on-line banking services**
- 6. Always exit our Internet Banking site using the logout button**
- 7. Disable automatic password-save features**
- 8. Do not use Memorize Account feature on publicly available computers**
- 9. If the computer you are using to access MemberDirect® accounts is less than 128 bit SSL security feature (such as a 40bit or 56bit SSL) you need to upgrade your browser before using our Internet Site**

Making safe Payments safer

Chip cards are coming, making a safe payment system even safer. A chip card is a credit or debit card containing an



embedded computer chip, which gives the card the ability to store and process data. Chip cards and chip terminals work together to ensure a highly secure transaction by validating the card and the cardholder. The computer chip provides additional protection to avoid disclosure of personal information. Chip cards are very difficult to copy, creating a multi-layered defence against fraud and identity theft. This doesn't mean you should stop doing your part. Shield your PIN from prying eyes, never give it away and don't write it down in your purse or wallet.

What will be different for me? When using your chip card to make a purchase, it will remain in the merchant's terminal for the duration of the transaction, rather than being 'swiped' through. As always, you'll enter your PIN and follow the prompts to complete your transaction. At an ATM you'll notice no difference at all. But in both cases, the chip card protects your information and makes your transaction more secure than ever. Cards will maintain a magnetic stripe that will allow them to be used in machines not yet converted to chip technology, or in locations such as the United States that have not made the transition.

What do I need to do? You will automatically receive your MemberCard chip card and Global Payment chip card in the mail once your card has been identified for conversion to chip. Before your card arrives, you'll receive your own personal identification number (PIN) in the mail. Your card will arrive a few days later. You can use the PIN sent to you or visit any Radius Credit Union branch to change your PIN. Your new chip card will have a different personal account number (PAN). This is the number found on the front of the card. It's also important to note that if you have a pre-authorized debit that is processed through your GLOBAL PAYMENT card, you'll need to call the billing company to inform them of your new card number. Please sign your new card and cut up your old MemberCard or Global Payment Card.
